# WEDNESDAY MARCH 6 TORONTO - ATHENS

Board your overnight flight to Greece.



# THURSDAY MARCH 7 ATHENS - DELPHI

Arrive in Athens and transfer to Delphi. Our coach shall pass the cities of Thebes and Livadia. During the Hellenistic period, Delphi was considered to be a sacred valley, the mythical point where the earth touched the divine. Located on the south-western side of Mt. Parnassus, in Greek mythology Delphi was home to the Pythian Oracle, but today is an impressive archeological excavation and UNESCO World Heritage Site. We will hike and tour the archeological sight and spend the night in Delphi. Overnight Delphi.



# FRIDAY MARCH 8 DELPHI - ATHENS

This morning we will transfer to our centrally located hotel in Athens, and after checking in, we will meet our guide for a panoramic drive that will include: Syntagma Square, National Garden, Hadrian's Arch, Parliament, Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, National Library, and Orthodox Church. Continue to Panathinaiko Stadium where the first modern Olympic games took place in 1896. Bus tour will be a hop-on, hop-off (where stops are permitted) for students to have a photo opportunity at these sites. This afternoon we will walk to the heights and tour the Agora, Temple of Athena Nike, Theatre of Dionysus and the incomparable doric Parthenon. Following this hike up the Acropolis, we will enjoy dinner in a local restaurant. Overnight Athens.

## SATURDAY MARCH 9 ATHENS

This morning we will enjoy a guided tour of the Acropolis museum. We will spend the afternoon in Plakka before a traditional Greek dinner. We will pack our bags when we return to the hotel in preparation for our flight to Rome tomorrow. Overnight Athens.



### SUNDAY MARCH 10 ATHENS - ROME

Board your coach and transfer to the airport for your flight to Rome. As soon as we arrive, we will drop our bags and start our tour by visiting the world-renowned 18th Century Spanish Steps, our walk will take us to the Piazza of Trevi with its spectacular fountain, through the Piazza Colonna distinguished by the Marcus Aurelius column in its centre to the Pantheon built by Agrippa in 27 B.C. and finally to the Piazza Navona, a 17th Century square that traces the oval form of the underlying Circus of Domitian. This first view of the city will emphasize the great span of architectural styles which make Rome a true metropolis. Overnight Rome.



## MONDAY MARCH 11 VATICAN CITY

Our programme today centres on the Vatican City and Papal Rome. The Vatican City, a 109 acre state, is surrounded by a wall built in the 9th Century and by the colonnade of St. Peter's Square. We will visit St. Peter's Basilica, one of the world's most majestic buildings standing over St. Peter's Tomb and the spot where he was martyred. We will also visit the Vatican Museum with its many treasures and see the Sistine Chapel where we marvel at the ceiling and the many splendid works of art. In the afternoon, there will be time for some shopping on via del corso with the GHT rep. Overnight Rome.



### ATHENS - ROME

Today's excursion into ancient Rome takes us to the Forum and the Colosseum. The Colosseum, opened by the Emperor Vespasian in AD 80, was where gladiator fights took place. Immensely impressive with a circumference of 530 metres and a height of 48 metres, the Colosseum was built to seat 50,000 spectators. The Roman Forum was the commercial, civil and religious centre of Roman life in the Republican Era. Afternoon will be spent exploring the trastevere district followed by dinner in an Osteria. Overnight Rome.



# WEDNESDAY MARCH 13 ROME - POMPEII - SORRENTO

Board your coach to Sorrento via
Pompeii for a tour of this ancient city.
Pompeii was a thriving commercial
centre when it was destroyed by the
devastating eruption of Vesuvius in AD
79. Two-thirds of the city has now been
excavated revealing a fascinating
example of urban geography. In
addition to several private homes and
temples, the guided tour includes:
Forum, Basilica, Baths, Street of Shops,
Theatres, and some free time to
explore further in Pompeii. Continue
onto Sorrento for dinner and overnight.

# THURSDAY MARCH 14 SORRENTO - CAPRI - SORRENTO

This morning, travel across the bay by hydrofoil to Capri - the "Island of Dreams". The Phoenicians were the island's earliest settlers, followed by the Greeks in the 4th-century BC, and then the Romans. The Emperors Augustus and Tiberius both constructed villas on the island. Later it became one of the strongholds of the Barbary pirate Barbarossa, who after sacking it, then made it his raiding base. Weather permitting, visit the famous Blue Grotto. We will tour Capri and the upper town of Anacapri to explore the main sights of the island. In the late afternoon, return to Sorrento for dinner at the hotel. Overnight Sorrento.



# SORRENTO - NAPLES - SORRENTO This morning we will travel to Naples where we will visit the National Archeological Museum in Naples and have lunch (at students' expense). This afternoon we will hike up Mount Vesuvius (weather permitting) followed by dinner at an outdoor restaurant situated in a beautiful vineyard looking out over Mount Vesuvius. Schedule permitting, we will enjoy live Neopolitan Music while we eat. Overnight Sorrento. \*\* If weather does not permit us to

climb Vesuvius, we will spend the afternoon in Naples visiting the antique market and visiting the EATALY food hall.

### SATURDAY MARCH 16 ROME

Ciao Italia! Board your private coach bus to the airport and catch your flight home to Toronto.
